POST-APPOINTMENT INFORMATION LASHES & BROWS

To ensure you get the very best results following your treatment, we recommend following the guidance below in the days after your appointment.

brow & lash

brow wax

- Avoid touching or rubbing the treated area.
- Refrain from applying make-up to the area for at least 24 hours after your treatment.
- Avoid exercise, saunas, sun beds, heat treatments, and hot baths/showers for at least 24 hours after your treatment.
- Do not use active skincare products such as retinols, AHAs or BHAs, or physical exfoliants for 48 hours after your treatment.
- Avoid sun exposure and sun beds during the healing period. This time will vary from client to client.
- Mild redness and slight swelling are common and usually settle within a few hours.
- Tenderness is normal, particularly for more sensitive skin.
- Light grazing may occur. This can appear as shiny areas or mild scabbing where the top layer of skin has lifted. This is completely normal, especially if the skin has been exfoliated or is thinner in the treated area.
- If light grazing occurs, keep the area clean and dry, avoid picking, and apply a soothing balm until fully healed.
- Small bumps may appear and typically resolve within 24–48 hours after your treatment.

brow lamination, lash lift & lash tint

- Keep lashes completely dry for the first 24 hours. This includes avoiding water, steam, creams, make-up and swimming.
- Avoid excessive heat such as saunas and sun beds for at least 24 hours after your treatment.
- Avoid hot showers and baths, for 24 hours after your treatment, and be mindful of steam from dishwashers or ovens.
- Try not to rub your eyes or sleep directly on your lashes or brows, as this can affect the position of the hairs.
- Use a lash and brow conditioning serum to help keep the hairs hydrated, reduce brittleness and support strength and longevity.
